supporting PhD students and ECI researchers from Participating ITC to attend international science and technology related conferences

eligible are

- exclusively for PhD students and ECI's¹ with a primary affiliation in an institution located in an ITC country²
- oral/poster presentation at the conference, listed in the official event/conference program
- subject of the oral presentation / poster must be on the topic of the Action and must acknowledge COST
- Participation must be pre-approved by the Action MC
- European conferences are preferred

between May 1st 2018 and February 28th 2019

(1 page max.)• documents about conference registration, registration fee, total estimated costs, acceptance of conference contribution
Evaluation criteria	<ol style="list-style-type: none">a) Gender (to ensure balance)b) Research match with the TREATme aims and the conference contributionc) Quality of the submitted contribution (novelty and scientific quality of research questions, methodology)

For criteria d and e: (1 = very low research match, no research question, low quality methodology; 10 = very high research match, specific, relevant research question, well-designed method)

To avoid conflict of interest when evaluating the applications, evaluators, who work at the same place with the applicant will be excluded (in that case the applicant would be evaluated by the rest of the committee only).

Priority will be given to those who have not received the Grant before.
